Those arriving with a car: parking at the ICC is available (upon availability) at the cost of 16 NIS per hour (the maximum reachable amount 60 NIS per day) for symposium participants.

Please take into consideration morning traffic into Jerusalem Public transportation is encouraged.

There will be a shuttle service between the Ramada Jerusalem hotel and the ICC Jerusalem (nearby hotels can join this shuttle; Prima Park and Jerusalem Gardens).

Speakers & Session Chairs

- Presentations should be prepared on Microsoft PowerPoint 16:9 ratio and should be submitted
 to the technician in the Speakers' Preview Room up to 2 hours prior to the beginning of your
 session on a disk-on-key (USB stick).
- Early morning session presenters are requested to bring their PowerPoint presentation to the technician in the Speakers' Preview Room the day before (if that is not possible, please bring it 30 min before the session starts).

Important note for Macintosh users: In order to use MAC presentations on a PC compatible computer, please note the following instructions while preparing your presentation prior to uploading in the lecture hall to avoid last minute problems of incompatibility:

- Please note that the symposium has no support for MAC presentations and, therefore, we ask speakers to convert their presentation to PowerPoint and test it on a PC computer before arriving to the Meeting.
- Use a common font, such as Arial, Times New Roman, Verdana etc. (special fonts might be changed to a default font on a PowerPoint based PC).
- Insert pictures as JPG files (and not TIF, PNG or PICT these images will not be visible on a PowerPoint based PC).
- Use a common movie format, such as AVI, MPG and WMV (MOV files from QuickTime will not be visible on a PowerPoint based PC).
- Please bring your MAC computer and adaptors with you as backup. Personal computers will be used, in rare cases.

Please use the poster board with your presentation number as listed in the program book (i.e. if your poster is listed as B1, use poster board 1). Poster presenters are requested to stand by their poster during the Poster Walk on **Wednesday August 30** at **18:35-20:35** to answer questions.

Mounting Material: Posters will be mounted to the boards with double-sided tape provided by the Secretariat.

Please note that the meeting secretariat is not responsible for posters that have not been removed or collected by the end of the meeting.

Airport transportation on Friday afternoon (Optional)

In consideration of the arrival of Shabbat (the Jewish Day of Rest), we are delighted to offer convenient transportation to conference attendees departing for the **Ben Gurion TLV airport** on Friday, September 1st.

Buses will depart from the ICC at 16:30 and 17:30. To allow ample time for boarding, the bus doors will be open 30 minutes prior to departure, and we kindly request all passengers to be present at the bus door.

Storage in the ICC will be offered on Friday until the time of departure for participants who book this service.

Secure your seat by booking no later than 48 hours before the departure date, by 17:00 on August 29th.

Note: The transportation costs **80 NIS per person** (non-refundable).

Important Note: As per BGA TLV Airport Security regulations, passengers are kindly advised to arrive at least 3 hours before their departure time for the security screening process.
